Join us Wednesday evening from 6:30-8 pm at Subterranean Gallery for a Writing Workshop led by poet and interdisciplinary artist [Leah](#)

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Silvius. This workshop is planned to be an interesting departure from our standard *Informality* programming. **“But you are the music / While the music lasts” : Art Criticism as Playlist** will aim to open up dialogue about art through the structure of the playlist.

Throughout the evening Silvius will show examples of authors who have constructed playlists for books or collections of poetry, which will become the inspiration for generating playlists for our own work or work that interests us. The goal of this is to open a broader discussion of the themes apparent, structural, and other aspects within artwork.

Writing is usually seen as the standard delivery method of commentary and critique, but how can a different medium, such as music, serve the same purpose? How do different types of media interact with each other?

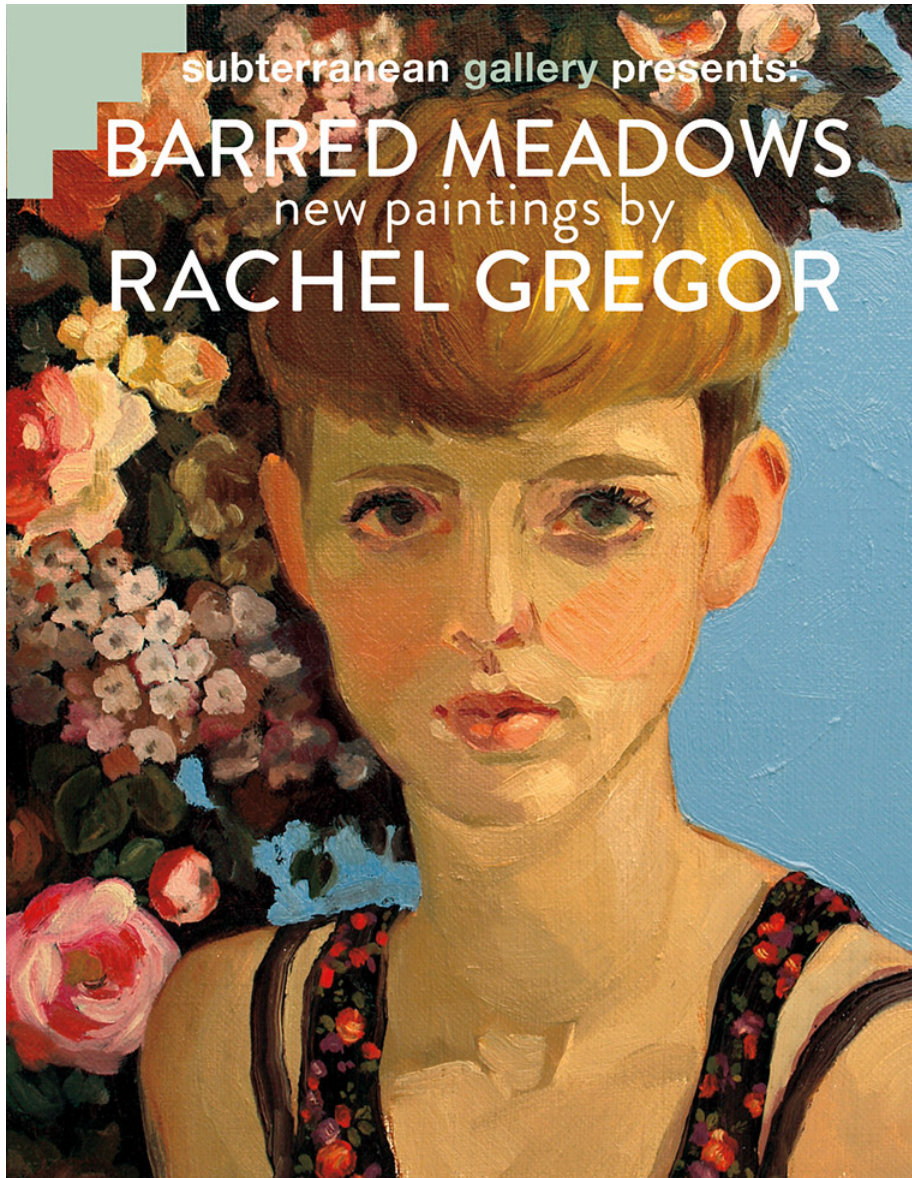
